

## Terms of use of marine data contained in Denmark's Depth Model, 50 m resolution

### General information

The Danish Geodata Agency handles property registration and nautical mapping in Denmark and Greenland. The Danish Geodata Agency has the intellectual property rights to Denmark's Depth Model, 50 m resolution (hereinafter called the 50M Model). The 50M Model forms part of the free marine data and the terms below manage the right of use. The use of marine data from the 50M Model implies a full and unrestricted acceptance of the following terms, which are regulated according to the Danish law in force at any given time.

### Right of use

The Danish Geodata Agency grants, taking into account the following section Terms and Source Attribution, a worldwide, free, non-exclusive and otherwise unlimited right to use data that can be freely:

- copied, distributed and published.
- combined with other material/data.
- used commercially and non-commercially.

### Terms

Data from the 50M Model may not be used for navigation or navigational purposes. Furthermore, it must not be used in such a way that it may appear that the Geodata Agency approves, supports, recommends or otherwise markets the user, the user's products or services.

It must be ensured that the use of data at all times is in accordance with applicable Danish law.

The Geodata Agency can at any time change, cancel, stop or otherwise close the download and services for the 50M Model.

The Geodata Agency may at any time change the right to use the data and the terms thereof. Data already downloaded when the new terms come into force can continue to be used on the terms in force so far. If data is updated with the Geodata Agency's data made available under the new terms, the new conditions apply to all data.

### Source attribution

The Danish Geodata Agency enforces its copyright. When data from the 50M Model is used, the user must ensure the following in a visible place suitable for the distribution medium:

1. Stating "Contains data from the Danish Geodata Agency".

2. Indication of the name "Denmark's Depth Model, 50 m resolution".
  
3. The date and time when the dataset(s) have been retrieved from the Danish Geodata Agency, or whether it is a data service (e.g.: "Contains data from Denmark's Depth Model, 50 m resolution from the Danish Geodata Agency, July 2022" or "Contains WMS service from the Danish Geodata Agency").
4. Ensure that the "Danish Geodata Agency – (Data may not be used for navigation)" appears on the front page of a service that uses datasets or data service prepared by the Danish Geodata Agency.
5. Make available to third parties a copy of these Terms, possibly by means of a link.
