



## Terms and conditions for the use of marine data contained in Denmark's Depth Model 50 m resolution

### General information

The Danish Geodata Agency owns the intellectual property rights to Denmark's Depth Model, 50 m resolution (hereinafter referred to as DDM50) as well as any updates hereof. DDM50 constitutes a part of the freely available marine data, and the terms below govern the right of use of the DDM50. thereof.

The use of marine data from DDM50 implies full and unrestricted acceptance of the terms below, which are regulated by the applicable Danish law at any given time.

### Right of use

The Danish Geodata Agency grants, subject to the sections below on Terms of Use and Attribution, a worldwide, free, non-exclusive, and otherwise unlimited right of use to marine data, which may freely be:

- copied, distributed, and published
- combined with other materials/data
- used for commercial and non-commercial purposes

### Terms of Use

Marine data from DDM50 may not be used for navigation or navigational purposes.

DDM50 may not be used in a manner that suggests that the Danish Geodata Agency approves, supports, recommends, or otherwise endorses the user, the user's products, or services.

It must be ensured that the use of marine data is at all times in accordance with applicable Danish law.

The Danish Geodata Agency may at any time change, cancel, cease, or otherwise close for downloads and services for DDM50.

The Danish Geodata Agency may at any time change the right of use to marine data and the terms hereof. Marine data that has already been downloaded when the new terms come into force may continue to be used under the previously applied terms. If the marine data is updated with marine data from the Danish Geodata Agency made available on the new terms, the new terms apply to all data.

A copy of these terms must be made available to third parties, possibly through a link. The terms also apply when third parties use data from DDM50.

### Attribution

The Danish Geodata Agency holds copyright to DDM50, therefore, it is a condition for the use of marine data from DDM50 that the following is stated prominently on the distribution medium:



1. "Contains data from the Danish Geodata Agency, Denmark's Depth Model, 50 m resolution".
2. "[Date]" indicating when the dataset was obtained from the Danish Geodata Agency

"Contains WMS service" if a WMS service is used.
3. "Model and data are not suitable for navigation".
